WP 1. STATUE GROUP: N51° 50.663 E5° 52.125

The theme of this bronze statue is derived from the Greek mythology. The.... were sisters (Klotho, Lachesis en Atropos) They determine fate and life of the human being

WP 2. BELVÉDÈRE TOWER: N51° 50.847 E5° 52.349

Originally the Belvédère was part of the towns defence works and city walls. It was erected in the second half of the 15th century.

WP 3. BARBAROSSA RUIN: N51° 50.838 E5° 52.217

The Barbarossa-ruin is an apse, building up from tufa and was a section of the palace (1155) from the emperor Frederik Barbarossa.

WP 5. RAILWAYMONUMENT: N51° 50.825 E5° 52.137

The railway monument, in the shape of an angel at the entrance to Valkhof Park was erected in commemoration of the first railway line built in 1865, which was a private enterprise and connected Nijmegen with Cleves in Germany.

WP 6. BESIENDERSHUIS: N51° 50.944 E5° 52.013

At the Steenstraat stands the so called Besiendershuis. This house built about 1525 thanks its name of the 'besiender', that should have lived here. The 'besiender' was a kind of tax collector for the ships passing on the river Waal. He had to collect the toll money of the passing ships.

WP 7. SINT-ANTHONISPOORT: N51° 50.995 E5° 51.767

This Gate - one of the two remaining gates - was part of the 14th-century city walls, but got it's definitive look in 1609-1610. Because of the flooding's the Waalkade is made higher, that's why the gate got too low for its original use. This already happened in the 17th century.

Just above the gate, you see a yellow stone with an inscription. Do the math, count everything, the numbers and the letters and count it to 1 number.

WP 8. KITTY DE WIJZEPLAATS: N51° 50.921 E5° 51.747

This is a memorial-place, designed by Paul de Swaaf and erected in memory of all the Jewish citizens of Nijmegen who were killed during the Second World War

WP 12. GROTE- OF STEVENSKERK: N51° 50.855 E5° 51.761

Construction on St Steven's Church began around 1254. The building started in Romanesque style but was completed in Gothic style.

WP 14. MARIKENSTRAAT: N51° 50.801 E5° 52.011

The name 'Mariken' refers to the main character in a famous medieval miracle play called Mariken van Nieumeghen. This name is inextricably linked with Nijmegen. The Marikenstraat is a two-level street with some 50 shops to turn your shopping into a fun experience. The architecture, the range of shops and the town centre location make Marikenstraat a unique shopping street. This street was built between 1998 and 2000 by the architects of Sjoerd Soeters.
